

Communication and Language

The children will be given lots of opportunities to retell and role-play our key stories. We have an indoor Little Red Riding Hood role play area and outside we have turned the shed into the ginger bread house from Hansel and Gretel.

Phonics

The children will continue to work in small phonic groups. They will continue to read and write sounds and we are now moving on to reading and writing simple sentences.

Maths

Children will work in maths groups where they will focus on number 11-20. The children will then move on to record simple equations. We will begin to look and describe 3-D shapes.
