

What we are learning this term:

ENGLISH

We will be following the Read, Write, Ink scheme for phonics, reading and writing. We will be reading lots pirate and arctic themed stories alongside this.

MATHS

We will be recognising number bonds to 10, counting objects up to 30 and writing the numerals up to 30, comparing numbers, finding 1 more/ 1 less than a number, count on from a number, identify longer and shorter, measure lengths and name and describe 2D shapes.

Please help your child learn to count in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s.

RE

We will be looking at stories about Jesus in the Bible. We will also be thinking about Harvest time.



THEME Land Ahoy! (Autumn 1)

Within theme, we will be learning about the continents and oceans. Investigating and comparing how boats and cars move; we will be making junk model boats to test our theories. We will learn and perform songs, before investigating into sources of sound and how volume changes with distance.
